

CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 6430

AN ORDINANCE amending 1) the 2017-2023 General Capital Investment Program (CIP) Plan to increase the budget for the Major Maintenance Program (CIP Plan No. PW-M-19) by \$280,971; and, 2) the 2017-2018 General CIP Fund to increase the appropriation by \$280,971 for maintenance work in the Eastgate Annexation Area and funded by annexation sales tax revenue provided through the State of Washington.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The 2017-2018 General Capital Investment Program (CIP) Fund, adopted by Ordinance No. 6333 on December 5, 2016, as previously amended, is hereby further amended to increase the appropriation to said CIP Fund by \$280,971.

Section 2. The City's 2017-2023 CIP Plan, adopted by Ordinance No. 6333 on December 5, 2016, as previously amended, is hereby further amended to increase the project budget for the Major Maintenance Program (CIP Plan No. PW-M-19) by \$280,971, for maintenance work in the Eastgate Annexation Area and funded by annexation sales tax revenue provided through the State of Washington.

Section 3. The appropriate administrative officials of the City are hereby authorized to receive monies and to expend the same.

Section 4. The City Manager or his designee shall have responsibility for the administration of said funds and expenditure of said funds received and shall have all authority necessary to enter into agreements regarding the use thereof.

Section 5. If the actual revenue received from the annexation sales tax revenue provided through the State for maintenance work in the Eastgate Annexation Area shall be more or less than that anticipated amount set forth herein, the appropriations to the CIP Fund and Plan shall be adjusted to be equal to the amount actually received.

Section 6. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after its passage and legal publication.
