

CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 6435

AN ORDINANCE 1) authorizing execution of a Department of Homeland Security (DHS) subgrant agreement (and supplements if necessary) with the Washington State Military Department to accept grant funds in the amount of \$256,701 for vulnerable populations planning, citizen preparedness and outreach and sustainment; 2) authorizing the deposit of said funds into the 2019-2020 budget of the Operating Grants, Donations, and Special Reserves Fund in the amount of \$256,701; 3) appropriating unanticipated and future revenues to that fund; and 4) authorizing expenditures of said grant funds.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Manager or his designee is authorized to execute a Subgrant Agreement (and supplements if necessary) with the Department of Homeland Security (DHS) in the amount of \$256,701 for vulnerable populations planning, citizen preparedness and outreach and sustainment with the Washington State Military Department, a copy of which Subgrant Agreement has been given Clerk's Receiving No. 74364.

Section 2. The appropriate administrative officials of the City are hereby authorized to receive monies and to expend the same as authorized in said Subgrant Agreement.

Section 3. At the time of execution of said Subgrant Agreement and acceptance of said funds, such grant funds shall be deposited in the Operating Grants, Donations, and Special Reserves Fund.

Section 4. Upon execution of said Subgrant Agreement, the budget for the Operating Grants, Donations and Special Reserves Fund shall be amended, if so necessary, by appropriating revenues in the amount of the grant and acceptance herein authorized.

Section 5. The approximate amount and anticipated source of revenue for the grant proposal and acceptance is:

Department of Homeland Security	\$256,701
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Provided, however, if the actual revenue received from the anticipated source specified in said Subgrant Agreement should be more or less than the anticipated amount set forth herein, the appropriation shall be adjusted to be equal to the amount actually received.

Section 6. The City Manager or his designee shall have responsibility for the administration of said grant monies and shall have all authority necessary to enter into agreements regarding the use thereof.

Section 7. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after passage and legal publication.
