

CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 6460

AN ORDINANCE authorizing 1) execution of a grant agreement (and supplements if necessary) with the Washington State Department of Transportation (WSDOT) to accept \$542,000 in federal Highway Safety Improvement Program (HSIP) funding to support construction of lighting improvements on SE Eastgate Way from Richards Road to 139th Avenue SE; 2) amending the 2019-2025 Capital Investment Program (CIP) Plan to increase the program budget for the Traffic Safety Improvements program (CIP Plan No. PW-R-46) by \$542,000; and, 3) amending the 2019-2020 General CIP Fund to increase the appropriation by \$542,000.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Manager or his designee is authorized to execute a grant agreement (and supplements if necessary) with the Washington State Department of Transportation (WSDOT) to accept \$542,000 in federal Highway Safety Improvement Program (HSIP) funding to support construction of lighting improvements on SE Eastgate Way from Richards Road to 139th Avenue SE, a copy of which grant agreement shall be substantially in the form given Clerk's Receiving No. 75178.

Section 2. The appropriate administrative officials of the City are hereby authorized to receive monies and to expend the same as authorized in said grant agreement.

Section 3. The City Manager or his designee shall have responsibility for the administration of said funds and expenditure of said funds received pursuant to said grant agreement and shall have all authority necessary to enter into agreements regarding the use thereof.

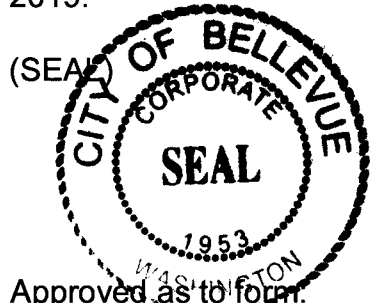
Section 4. The 2019-2020 General Capital Investment Program (CIP) Fund, adopted by Ordinance No. 6445 on December 3, 2018, as previously amended, is hereby further amended to increase the appropriation to said CIP Fund by \$542,000.

Section 5. The City's 2019-2025 CIP Plan, adopted by Ordinance No. 6445 on December 3, 2018, as previously amended, is hereby further amended to increase the program budget for the Traffic Safety Improvements program (CIP Plan No. PW-R-46) by \$542,000 awarded from the Washington State Department of Transportation Highway Safety Improvement Program funding.

Section 6. If the actual revenue received from Washington State Department of Transportation Highway Safety Improvement Program funding shall be more or less than the anticipated amount set forth herein, the appropriations to the CIP Fund and Plan shall be adjusted to be equal to the amount actually received.

Section 7. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after its passage and legal publication.


