

CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 6478

AN ORDINANCE 1) authorizing execution of an Interlocal Agreement (and supplements if necessary) with King County Metro (KCM) for acceptance of \$200,000 in pass-through grant funds from KCM for the City-wide Transportation Demand Management (TDM) Implementation Program 2019-2020; 2) amending the 2019-2020 Operating Grants, Donations and Special Reserves Fund by increasing the appropriation by \$200,000; and, 3) authorizing execution of a professional services contract (and supplements if necessary) with Bellevue Downtown Association in the total reimbursement amount of \$155,000, plus all applicable taxes, for trip reduction services associated with implementing the TDM Implementation Program 2019-2020.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Manager or his designee is authorized to execute an Interlocal Agreement (and supplements if necessary) with King County Metro (KCM) for acceptance of \$200,000 in pass-through grant funds from KCM for the City-wide TDM Implementation Program 2019-2020, a copy of which agreement shall be substantially in the form given Clerk's Receiving No. 75432.

Section 2. The appropriate administrative officials of the City are hereby authorized to receive monies and to expend the same as authorized in said Interlocal Agreement.

Section 3. The City Manager or his designee shall have responsibility for the administration of said funds and expenditure of said funds received pursuant to said Interlocal Agreement and shall have all authority necessary to enter into agreements regarding the use thereof.

Section 4. At the time of execution of said Interlocal Agreement and acceptance of said funds, a project shall be established within the Operating Grants, Donations and Special Reserves Fund into which all said respective grant monies shall be deposited.

Section 5. The approximate amount and anticipated source of revenue for said grant monies is:

Congestion Mitigation & Air Quality (CMAQ)

\$200,000

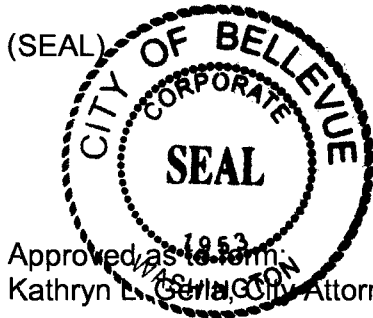
Section 6. Upon execution of said Interlocal Agreement, the budget for the 2019-2020 Operating Grants, Donations and Special Reserves Fund shall be amended by appropriating \$200,000 to said fund.

Provided, however, if the actual revenue received from the anticipated sources specified in said Interlocal Agreement shall be more or less than the anticipated amount set forth herein, the appropriations shall be adjusted to be equal to the amount actually received.

Section 7. The City Manager or his designee is authorized to execute a professional services contract (and supplements if necessary) with the Bellevue Downtown Association to add up to \$155,000, plus all applicable taxes, for trip reduction services associated with implementing the TDM Implementation Program 2019-2020, a copy of which contract shall be substantially in the form given Clerk's Receiving No. 15433.

Section 8. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after its passage and legal publication.
