

CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 6479

AN ORDINANCE 1) amending the 2019-2025 Capital Investment Program (CIP) Plan to reduce the scope and budget for design of the Mountains to Sound Greenway trail project (CIP Plan No. PW-W/B-78) by \$533,000 to reflect the return of \$653,000 in federal grant funds awarded for the design of trail segments east of 150th Avenue SE, offset by a \$120,000 budget transfer from the Eastgate Subarea Plan Implementation project (CIP Plan No. PW-R-177); and, 2) amending the 2019-2020 General CIP Fund appropriation to decrease by \$653,000.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City's 2019-2025 General Capital Investment Program (CIP) Plan, adopted by Ordinance No. 6445 on December 3, 2018, as previously amended, is hereby further amended to:

A. Amend the project description/scope and budget for CIP Plan No. PW-W/B-78, Mountains to Sound Greenway trail project as set forth in Attachment A attached hereto. Attachment A shall replace page 423 of the Plan.

B. Decrease the project budget for the Mountains to Sound Greenway trail project (CIP Plan No. PW-W/B-78) by \$533,000, for a total project budget of \$3,028,173, to reflect the return of \$653,000 in federal grant funds awarded for the design of trail segments east of 150th Avenue SE.

C. Transfer \$120,000 from the Eastgate Subarea Plan Implementation project (CIP Plan No. PW-R-177) to the Mountains to Sound Greenway trail project (CIP Plan No. PW-W/B-78), to offset the return of grant funds, for a total project budget for CIP Plan No. PW-R-177 of \$380,000.

Section 2. The 2019-2020 General CIP Fund, adopted by Ordinance No. 6445 on December 3, 2018, as previously amended, is hereby further amended to decrease the appropriation to said CIP Fund by \$653,000.


Section 3. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after its passage and legal publication.




