

CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 6497

AN ORDINANCE 1) authorizing execution of a grant agreement with King County for \$110,000 through the King County Flood Reduction Grant Program; 2) amending the 2019-2020 Biennium General Capital Investment Program (CIP) fund to increase the appropriation by \$110,000 for Parks Renovation and Refurbishment Plan (P-R-11); and 3) modifying the 2019-2025 CIP Plan to increase the Parks Renovation and Refurbishment Plan (P-R-11) by \$110,000 to assist with renovation and replacement of existing flood control infrastructure at the Mercer Slough Blueberry Farm.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Manager or his designee is authorized to execute a grant agreement with King County to accept \$110,000 in grant funding from the King County Flood Reduction Grant Program for renovation and replacement of existing flood control infrastructure at the Mercer Slough Blueberry Farm, a copy of which grant agreement shall be substantially in the form given Clerk's Receiving No. 75698.

Section 2. The appropriate administrative officials of the City are hereby authorized to receive monies and to expend the same as authorized in said grant agreement.

Section 3. The City Manager or his designee shall have responsibility for the administration of said funds and expenditure of said funds received pursuant to said grant agreement and shall have all authority necessary to enter into agreements regarding the use thereof.

Section 4. The City's 2019-2020 Biennium General Capital Investment Program (CIP) fund, adopted by Ordinance No. 6493 on December 2, 2019, is amended to increase the appropriation by \$110,000 for Parks Renovation and Refurbishment Plan (P-R-11).

Section 5. The City's 2019-2025 CIP Plan, adopted by Ordinance No. 6493 on December 2, 2019, is amended to increase the Parks Renovation and Refurbishment Plan (P-R-11) by \$110,000.

Section 6. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after its passage and legal publication.
