## CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON

## ORDINANCE NO. 6509

AN ORDINANCE amending Ordinance 6493, adopted December 2, 2019, as previously amended, to increase the General Fund 2019-2020 biennial appropriation by \$1,102,156 for CARES Mobile Integrated Health and Basic Life Services.

WHEREAS, on November 5, 2019, King County voters approved King County Proposition 1 Emergency Medical Services Property Tax Levy Renewal, to continue funding Medic One emergency medical services; and

WHEREAS, the City of Bellevue's 2019-2020 mid-biennial budget adopted on December 2, 2019 did not include appropriations for the voter approved ballot proposition due to the timing of the King County election; now therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City's 2019-2020 mid-biennial budget, adopted by Ordinance No. 6493 on December 2, 2019, as previously amended, is hereby further amended to increase the General Fund 2019-2020 biennial appropriation by \$1,102,156 to reflect EMS Levy funding to be received from King County.

Section 2. The appropriate administrative officials of the City are hereby authorized to receive the monies anticipated herein and to expend the same for the purposes set forth herein, including but not limited to increasing staffing to support the Emergency Medical Services (EMS) programs.

Section 3. If the actual revenue received from the anticipated sources specified herein is more or less than the anticipated amount set forth herein, the appropriations shall be adjusted to equal the amount actually received.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after its passage and legal publication.
