RESOLUTION NO. 9642

A RESOLUTION RELATING TO PROVIDING MEN'S
HOMELESS SHELTER SERVICES

WHEREAS, since July 2018, the City of Bellevue has been working toward providing temporary year-round men's homeless shelter services at Lincoln Center, which requires fire and life safety improvements prior to operating as an overnight shelter; and

WHEREAS, while work at Lincoln Center is expected to be completed this fall, a temporary interim "bridge" shelter location is needed pending completion of the Lincoln Center shelter upgrades; and

WHEREAS, the Lincoln Center site is a temporary solution to address year-round men's homeless shelter needs; and

WHEREAS, one of the Council's priorities is to work toward a solution for a permanent men's homeless shelter;

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES
RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Manager is directed to prepare and present at the Council's August 5 Regular Session meeting a proposal for funding the operational services of the bridge and Lincoln Center shelters beginning as early as September 2019.

Section 2. The City Manager is directed to conduct public outreach within the Downtown and Wilburton neighborhoods concerning the operation of the temporary bridge and Lincoln Center shelters.


Section 3. The City Manager is directed to provide periodic reports to the Council on the progress toward siting a permanent men's homeless shelter.

Section 4. The City Manager is directed to consider necessary funding toward the operating expenses at the Lincoln Center shelter within the preliminary 2021-2022 biennial budget.
