A RESOLUTION authorizing submittal of two grant applications to the State of Washington's Recreation and Conservation Office (RCO). The first application requests up to \$1.18 million to assist with the cost of constructing a multi-use trail at Mercer Slough Nature Park to connect the Mountains to Sound and Eastrail regional trails. The second application requests up to \$1.85 million to assist with potential property acquisition on Lake Sammamish.

Section 1. The City Manager or his designee is hereby authorized to submit two grant applications to the State of Washington's Recreation and Conservation Office (RCO).
